**Matthew David Cormia**  
**Case No. 2016-028378**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$750.00 plus costs and 32 hours of continuing education within 150 days against Matthew David Cormia’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Cormia affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Cormia was chosen for the audit and has only provided 10 hours of continuing education during the audit period.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order accepting a voluntary relinquishment of Christian H. Crookless’ license to practice architecture.

**Michael L. Ellingwood**

**Case No. 2016-036373**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing reprimand and a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs against Michael L. Ellingwood’s license to practice interior design. Mr. Ellingwood entered into a contract to perform general contracting services for a residence, which contains professions he is not licensed to perform. Further Mr. Ellingwood is offering architectural services through a fictitious name without a certificate of authorization.

**Scotty Allen Ford**  
**Case No. 2015-053440**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing revocation plus costs against Scotty Allen Ford’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Ford failed to pay the fine and costs of \$1,485.00 required by Final Order entered on August 6, 2014.

**Scotty Allen Ford**  
**Case No. 2016-043429**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$3,000.00 plus costs against Scotty Allen Ford's license to practice architecture. Mr. Ford signed and sealed a false inspection report, on the letterhead of an unlicensed firm, while his license was in a delinquent status.

**Philip Hudson Gott**  
**Case No. 2016-001627**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order accepting a voluntary relinquishment of Philip Hudson Gott's license to practice architecture.

**Reza A. Hadaegh**  
**Case No. 2016-028017**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 against Reza A. Hadaegh's license to practice architecture. Mr. Hadaegh affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Hadaegh was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of the advanced building code course.

**Louis Chris Kallinosis**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs and 19 hours of continuing education within 30 days against Louis Chris Kallinosis' license to practice architecture. Mr. Kallinosis affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Kallinosis was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of any continuing education hours obtained during the audit period.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing 39 hours of continuing education against Sarah M. Karram's license to practice interior design. Ms. Karram was chosen for the audit and has only provided 1 hour of continuing education during the audit period.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$250.00 plus costs and 9.5 hours of continuing education within 90 days against Alexander P. Lamis' license to practice architecture. Mr. Lamis affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Lamis was chosen for the audit and has only provided 20.5 hours of continuing education during the audit period.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$750.00 plus costs and 34 hours of continuing education within 150 days against Steven M. Lawler's license to practice architecture. Mr. Lawler affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Lawler was chosen for the audit and has only provided 7.5 hours of continuing education during the audit period.

**Lawrence Albert Marek**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, 48 hours of continuing education and suspension until compliance against Lawrence Albert Marek's license to practice architecture. Mr. Marek affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Marek was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of any continuing education hours obtained during the audit period.

Mr. Molina affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Molina was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of the Florida Building Code course.

**Jeffrey Lee Schantz**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$500.00 plus costs and completion of the Building Code course against Jeffrey Lee Schantz's license to practice architecture. Mr. Schantz affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Schantz was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of the advanced building code course.

**Cardid Maria Sola**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, 48 hours of continuing education and suspension until compliance against Cardid Maria Sola's license to practice architecture. Ms. Sola affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Sola was chosen for the audit and has not provided proof of any continuing education hours obtained during the audit period.
