**E. Dean Bolaris**  
**Case No. 2017-055205**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a two years probation, a fine of \$3,787.50 plus costs against E. Dean Bolaris’ license to practice architecture. Mr. Bolaris failed to pay the fine and costs of \$3,787.50 required by Final Order entered on March 23, 2017.

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$5,000.00 plus costs against Suinglio J. Espejo and SJE Design & Construction. Mr. Espejo contracted to provide signed and sealed drawings for a commercial project and is using the title architect.

**Jose G. Solares**  
**Design by Solares Del Forn**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed enter a final order imposing a fine of \$3,000.00 plus costs against Jose G. Solares and Design by Solares Del Forn. Jose G. Solares and Design by Solares Del Forn are not licensed to practice architecture. Mr. Solares is contracting to provide architectural services and offering architectural services on his website. Further, Mr. Solares is offering architectural services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization.

**Kennard D. Tate**  
**Case No. 2017-056204**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,000.00 plus costs, forty five hours of continuing education within 180 days against Kennard D. Tate’s license to practice architecture. Mr. Tate affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Tate was chosen for the audit and has provided only three hours of continuing education during the audit period.

**Sheng-Ming Wang**

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order accepting a voluntary relinquishment of Sheng-Ming Wang's license to practice architecture.
