The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order approving a settlement stipulation imposing a fine of \$1,500.00 plus costs against AYD International d/b/a Amy Young Designs and Amy Young Lee McArdle. Ms. McArdle and the company are not licensed to practice architecture are offering architectural services on their web site and claims to have an in-house architect.
