Ronald Jean Baptiste
Case No. 2021-010591

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$10,000.00 plus costs against Ronald Jean Baptiste. Mr. Baptiste is not licensed to practice architecture and is offering architectural services and using the title architect.

Steve Delbrune
Case No. 2021-019982

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing a fine of \$2,500.00 plus costs against Steve Delbrune. Mr. Delbrune is not licensed to practice architecture and is offering architectural services and using the title architect.

Victor Liberatore
Case No. 2021-048086

The Florida Board of Architecture and Interior Design agreed to enter a final order imposing revocation against Victor Liberatore license to practice interior design. Mr. Liberatore failed to provide proof of the continuing education hours required by the Final Order entered on August 20, 2015.
