**I. Unlicensed Cases**

**Ampersand Construction, LLC**  
**Allan Livesey**  
**Case No. 2012-033182**

Probable cause was found that Ampersand Construction, LLC and Allan Livesey of Sarasota, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Livesey sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Livesey fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**ART & STYLO, Inc.**  
**Ravaal Almada**  
**Case No. 2013-004016**

Probable cause was found that ART & STYLO, Inc. and Ravaal Almada of Miami, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida. Mr. Almada was issued a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist on May 21, 2013 and has not responded. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Anamaria Atias**  
**Anamaria Atias Design and Espacios 3D Corp.**  
**Case No. 2012-048145**

Probable cause was found that Anamaria Atias and Anamaria Atias Design and Espacios 3D Corp. of Weston, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture or commercial interior design in Florida and are offering architectural and commercial interior design services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural and commercial interior design services was issued along with the requirement that Ms. Atias sign an affidavit stating she has changed her website and will not offer such services in the future. If Ms. Atias fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**James Atkinson**  
**CADD Design & Estimating Group, Inc.**  
**Case No. 2013-023565**

Probable cause was found that James Atkinson. and CADD Design & Estimating Group, Inc. of Merritt Island, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Atkinson sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Atkinson fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Elmar R. Benavente**  
**Case No. 2012-048121**

Probable cause was found that Elmar R. Benavente of Boca Raton, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and is offering architectural services on his website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Benavente sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Benavente fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**D.O.T.I., Inc.**  
**Michele Evanger**  
**Case No. 2012-034783**

Probable cause was found that D.O.T.I., Inc. and Michele Evanger of Ponte Vedra Beach, FL, are not licensed to practice interior design in Florida and are offering commercial design services on their website. Further, Ms. Evanger is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

**JAG Home Design**  
**Al Giachetti**  
**Case No. 2012-048675**

Probable cause was found that JAG Home Design and Al Giachetti of Delray Beach, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Giachetti sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Giachetti fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Jason Kubisiak**  
**Start to Finish Drafting, LLC**  
**Case No. 2013-034550**

Probable cause was found that Jason Kubisiak and Start to Finish Drafting, LLC of Sarasota, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Kubisiak sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Kubisiak fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Robert M. Long, Jr.**  
**Aluminum Construction Services, Inc.**  
**Case No. 2012-040512**

Probable cause was found that Robert M. Long, Jr. and Aluminum Construction Services, Inc. of North Point, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida; however Mr. Long is a licensed general contractor. Mr. Long aided and abetted the unlicensed practice of architecture. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Long sign an affidavit stating he will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Long fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Carlos J. Peralta**  
**Case No. 2012-048129**

Probable cause was found that Carlos J. Peralta of Boca Raton, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and is offering architectural services on his website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Peralta sign an affidavit stating he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Peralta fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Sandra Palmieri**  
**Sandra Palmieri Design, Inc.**  
**Case No. 2013-035065**

Probable cause was found that Sandra Palmieri and Sandra Palmieri Design, Inc. of Boca Raton, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Ms. Palmieri sign an affidavit stating that she has changed her website and will not offer such services in the future. If Ms. Palmieri fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Snyder Drafting Services, Inc.**  
**Robert L. Snyder**  
**Case No. 2012-040509**

Probable cause was found that Snyder Drafting Services, Inc. and Robert L. Snyder of Port Charlotte, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and prepared architectural drawings for a commercial project. Further, Mr. Snyder is offering these services through a corporation without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed and a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist will be issued.

**Yomar Consulting, Inc.**  
**Glomar Nice**  
**Case No. 2012-049728**

Probable cause was found that Yomar Consulting, Inc. and Glomar Nice of Wilton Manors, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering architectural services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Nice sign an affidavit stating that he has changed his website and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Nice fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**II. Licensed Cases**

**Conrad Augusto Bonet**  
**Case No. 2013-030178**

Probable cause was found that Conrad Augusto Bonet of Miami, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Bonet was chosen for the audit and has not provided any evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Georgia L. Carlee**  
**Case No. 2013-030184**

Probable cause was found that Georgia L. Carlee of Santa Rosa Beach, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Carlee was chosen for the audit and has not provided any evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**David M. Chason**  
**Case No. 2012-052922**

Probable cause was found that David M. Chason of Weston, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Chason was chosen for the audit and has not provided any evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Aaron S. Cohen**  
**Case No. 2013-030232**

Probable cause was found that Aaron S. Cohen of Croton on Hudson, NY, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Cohen was chosen for the audit and provided proof of only seventeen and a half hours of continuing education. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Constance A. Davidson**  
**Case No. 2013-041253**

Probable cause was found that Constance A. Davidson, of Ft. Myers, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Davidson was chosen for the audit and provided proof of only eighteen hours of continuing education. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**George G. Demmy**  
**Case No. 2013-030237**

Probable cause was found that George G. Demmy of Pensacola, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Demmy was chosen for the audit and provided proof of only thirteen hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Scotty Allen Ford**  
**Case No. 2013-031705**

Probable cause was found that Scotty Allen Ford of Naples, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Ford was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Carlos Gles**  
**Case No. 2012-052927**

Probable cause was found that Carlos Gles of St. Petersburg, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Gles was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Ida Sarah Goldstein**  
**Case No. 2013-008862**

Probable cause was found that Ida Sarah Goldstein of Palm Beach, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Goldstein was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed

**Jason K. Gove**  
**Case No. 2013-039601**

Probable cause was found that Jason K. Gove, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Gove was chosen for the audit and has not provided any evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Peter E. Gray**  
**Case No. 2013-041240**

Probable cause was found that Peter E. Gray of Dunedin, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Gray was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only four hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed

**Peter R. Krause**  
**Case No. 2013-030234**

Probable cause was found that Peter R. Krause of Riverdale, NJ, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Krause was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only seven hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**John T. Lamb**  
**Case No. 2013-039589**

Probable cause was found that John T. Lamb of Coral Springs, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Lamb was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Jay Christopher Lovell**

Probable cause was found that Jay Christopher Lovell of Orlando, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Lovell was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed

**Randall James Marks**  
**Case No. 2013-029794**

Probable cause was found that Randall James Marks of St. Petersburg, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Marks was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Gerald Joseph Oakley**  
**Case No. 2013-033314**

Probable cause was found that Gerald Joseph Oakley of Palm Beach Gardens, FL, a Florida licensed architect, has failed to pay the fine and costs required by the Final Order entered on July 7, 2008. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Ricardo E. Ramos**  
**Case No. 2013-017833**

Probable cause was found that Ricardo E. Ramos of Valrico, FL, a Florida licensed architect, was placed on probation by the Mississippi Board for failing to exercise responsible supervisory control. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Carlos A. Restrepo**  
**Case No. 2013-039555**

Probable cause was found that Carlos A. Restrepo of Coral Springs, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Restrepo was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only fifteen hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Peter Thomas Ricci**  
**Case No. 2013-024768**

Probable cause was found that Peter Thomas Ricci of West Caldwell, NJ, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Ricci was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only seventeen hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Mark D. Sefiner**  
**MDS Architect, PC**  
**Case No. 2012-032876**

Probable cause was found that Mark D. Sefiner of Valrico, FL, a Florida licensed architect, signed and sealed drawings while his license was in a null and void status. Further, Mr. Sefiner is offering architectural services through a business entity without a certificate of authorization. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Donald P. Senatore**  
**Case No. 2013-039606**

Probable cause was found that Donald P. Senatore of Pompano Beach, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Senatore was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Kevin Eric Smith**  
**Case No. 2012-052985**

Probable cause was found that Kevin Eric Smith of Warrington, PA, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Smith was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Ms. Tischler was chosen for the audit and has not provided any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Timothy Alan Wagoner**  
**Case No. 2013-030221**

Probable cause was found that Timothy Alan Wagoner of Orlando, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Wagoner was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only twelve hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Christina L. Zagorac**  
**Case No. 2013-030193**

Probable cause was found that Christina L. Zagorac of Tampa, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits.
