I. Unlicensed Cases

**Michael E. Craddock
Case No.: 2015-022690**

Probable cause was found that Michael E. Craddock of Boca Raton, FL, was previously licensed; however, his license went delinquent on March 1, 2003, and then into a null and void status on March 1, 2005. Mr. Craddock contracted for architectural services, held himself out as an architect and used his null and void license number. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

Probable cause was found that Carol Cooper of Brandon, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, affirmed at renewal that she had completed the required continuing education credits. Ms. Cooper was chosen for the audit and has provided proof of only 18.5 hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Brian Joseph Garland
Case No. 2015-044139**

Probable cause was found that Brian Joseph Garland of Jupiter, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Garland was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Designworks Creative Partnership, Ltd.

Probable cause was found that Steven M. Hefner and Designworks Creative Partnership, Ltd. of Pompano Beach, FL. Mr. Hefner is a Florida licensed interior designer, and allegedly was paid approximately \$25,000 for items that were never received. Further, Mr. Hefner is offering interior design services through a null and void certificate of authorization number and offering architectural services on his web site. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Probable cause was found that Eric L. Kreher of Tampa, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Kreher was chosen for the audit and has not provided evidence of any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

William H. Lindner

Probable cause was found that William H. Lindner of Tallahassee, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits.
