I. Licensed Cases

Emilio Jose Agrenot
Case No. 2017-024390

Probable cause was found that Emilio Jose Agrenot of Miami Lakes, FL, a Florida licensed architect, failed to perform under a contract to provide permit ready drawings even though he was paid \$9,750.00. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Gregory Sterling Goertler
Case Nos. 2014-047226

Probable cause was found that Gregory Sterling Goertler of Mentor, OH, a Florida licensed architect, aided the unlicensed practice of architecture by signing a letter with his license number on the letterhead of an unlicensed firm for a commercial project. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

HDR Architecture, Inc.
Case No. 2016-057964

Probable cause was found that HDR Architecture, Inc. of Omaha, NE, a Florida licensed architectural firm, represented in bid documents that an individual was a licensed architect when he did not have an active license. Further, HDR Architecture, Inc. failed to notify DBPR that its qualifier died in 2003. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Steven M. Hefner
Case No. 2017-025137

Probable cause was found that Steven M. Hefner of Hillsboro Beach, FL, a Florida licensed interior designer, failed to comply with a lawful order of the Board by failing to pay \$5,235.00 in fines and costs. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Eduardo Hillman-Waller
Case No. 2017-027166

Probable cause was found that Eduardo Hillman-Waller of Coral Gables, FL, a Florida licensed architect, was convicted of conspiracy to commit wire fraud and transport money obtained by fraud while acting as the project manager for the Piarco International Airport serving Trinidad and Tobago. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Leonard Jansen LaForest
Case No. 2016-055678

Probable cause was found that Leonard Jansen LaForest of Hollywood, FL, a Florida licensed architect, signed and sealed drawings for a retention wall wherein violations were found. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Peggy Oberlin
Case No. 2017-025145

Probable cause was found that Peggy Oberlin of Cayce, SC, a Florida licensed interior designer, failed to comply with a lawful order of the Board by failing to appear before the Probation Committee and failing to pay \$5,975.50 in fines and costs. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Ruben J. Pujol
Case No. 2016-038021

Probable cause was found that Ruben J. Pujol of Miami, FL, a Florida licensed architect, provided responsibility supervisory control over two architectural firms and at two different locations. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

Jeffrey Scott Waddell
Case No. 2016-044090

Probable cause was found that Jeffrey Scott Waddell of Panama City, FL, a Florida licensed architect, aided an unlicensed firm in the offering of architectural services. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.
