**I. Unlicensed Cases**

**Design Pros  
Barry Webb  
Case No. 2021-005029**

Probable cause was found that Design Pros and Barry Webb of Largo, FL, are not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and are offering architectural services on their website. An Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**Sean Kessler  
Case No.: 2021-010587**

Probable cause was found that Sean Kessler of Brooksville, FL, is not licensed to practice architecture in Florida and is contracting to provide design services for a commercial project. A Notice and Order to Cease and Desist from offering design services was issued along with the requirement that Mr. Kessler sign an affidavit stating he has changed his contracts, and will not offer such services in the future. If Mr. Kessler fails to return the affidavit, an Administrative Complaint seeking fines will be filed.

**II. Licensed Cases**

**Matthew Konar  
Case No. 2020-043842**

Probable cause was found that Matthew Konar of Durham, NC, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Konar was chosen for the audit and did not provide any hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Gerald Nyren  
Case No. 2020-044526**

Probable cause was found that Gerald Nyren of Jacksonville, FL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Nyren was chosen for the audit and only provided 17.5 hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**John Summitt**  
**Case No. 2020-055549**

Probable cause was found that John Summitt of Bethlehem, PA, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Summitt was chosen for the audit and only provided 3 hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.

**Leif Eric Widholm**  
**Case No. 2020-052482**

Probable cause was found that Leif Eric Widholm of Chicago, IL, a Florida licensed architect, affirmed at renewal that he had completed the required continuing education credits. Mr. Widholm was chosen for the audit and only provided 12.5 hours of continuing education during the audit period. An Administrative Complaint seeking discipline will be filed.
